## INFORMATION SHEET FOR APPLICANTS FOR ADMISSION TO 1<sup>ST</sup> SEM U.G PROGRAMME (SESSION: 2023-24)

Admission to 1st Semester Programme (Science & Arts) Courses will be strictly on the basis of merit and through online portal (**web: [www.indasmahavidyalaya.in](http://www.indasmahavidyalaya.in) / [www.indasmahavidyalaya.org](http://www.indasmahavidyalaya.org)** ).

- A. Applicants passed H.S./Equivalent Examination from General Stream course (Bengali & English Medium Only) in 2021, 2022 & 2023 are only eligible to apply for admission to U.G. Programme (session 2023-24).**

### **B. FOR VOCATIONAL COURSES:**

- Students who have passed Vocational Engineering and Technology (with pass marks in Mathematics) equivalent to 10+2 or equivalent level are eligible for admission to Science or Arts in the First Semester. Those who have passed without Mathematics or without securing pass marks in Mathematics are eligible for admission to Arts.
- Students who have passed Vocational Agriculture equivalent to 10+2 or equivalent level are eligible for admission to Science or Arts.
- Students who have passed Vocational Business and Commerce equivalent to 10+2 or equivalent level are eligible for admission to Arts.
- Students who have passed Vocational Home Science equivalent to 10+2 or equivalent level are eligible for admission to Arts.

**Note: In case of vocational courses' candidates there will be a deduction of 15 percentage marks from their aggregate in the 10+2 or equivalent level examination.**

- 75% attendance is mandatory for all admitted students in the class for first two weeks of commencement of class.

#### 4. **HOW TO APPLY**

The online admission site of the College has been designed in a user friendly way to help candidates for applying online in a step-by-step fashion. It has two major stages.

- Registration and
- Admission.

- Click **Admission Form Fill Up (Right upper corner)**
- Then fill-up form
- The online application allows to upload scanned photograph (up to 30kb) & signature (up to 20kb)
- After filling-up click **PROCEED**
- Review & check Application Form
- If all pre-filled data are right then click Final Submit
- You have to upload (pdf/jpg format):**
  - 1) **Secondary Admit/Age Proof**
  - 2) **Secondary Mark sheet**
  - 3) **H.S.(Equivalent) Registration Certificate**
  - 4) **H.S./Equivalent Mark sheet**
  - 5) **EWS Certificate/ Caste Certificate and/or PWD Certificate(if any) by clicking 'choose file' then 'submit' same file**
- Click **NEXT**
- Choose your Major Subject according to your preferences
- And click **Submit**

It is important to mention that in all the cases the candidate should note the **ONLINE REGISTRATION NUMBER**, failing which it may be difficult for making bank payment at the time of admission through online process. The same registration number should be used by the candidate for further tracking of his/her candidature at different stages.

Candidates are requested to give their valid e-mail ID & mobile no. during filling the admission form and must hold that mobile no. up to final semester because candidate have to Login at any time by using **User Name (Registration No) & Password** which are sent to their mobile number as well as email and these also used to received all sms, UID and Password from Bankura University also.

Prospective candidates are advised to follow the message sent to their mobile by Indas Mahavidyalaya and also visit our college website ([www.indasmahavidyalaya.in](http://www.indasmahavidyalaya.in) and [www.indasmahavidyalaya.org](http://www.indasmahavidyalaya.org)) notice board at regular intervals for updates.

- After publishing merit list, visit our website (<https://www.indasmahavidyalaya.org>)
- Click notice
- Again click “merit list published”-click here to view merit list
- If your status is **CONFIRMED** then Login by **USER NAME & PASSWORD** sent to your mobile number
- Then click “Check Merit Point” (Right upper Corner)
- Click “action drop down” and click “accept”
- Then click “Final Submit”
- Choose your subject combination from the list
- Then click submit
- Then pay your admission fee by online
- After filling up necessary information at each stage properly candidate should pay the requisite amount to the college through online payment system (built up in the software), without which the candidature of the candidate will be cancelled. Mode of online payment will be displayed in the software itself and the candidate should choose any one of them (Net Banking, Debit Card, Credit Card, Cash Card, Any other payments App. (A nominal TDR charge would be applicable).
- After payment you may have to come to the college on the scheduled day for verification as per government and university guidelines, along with printed online “Application Form”, photocopy of all testimonials and all original, to complete the admission process.
- If status is confirmed and a candidate does not accept then he/she will not get any chance to accept that subject in the next merit list.
- A candidate may take advantage of changing Major subject (two times) after taking admission, if his/her name is enlisted in the corresponding merit list.
- Rights of cancellation or selection/admission lie with the Admission Committee of the Institute concerned.
- If a candidate gives wrong information or misguides the college, then his/her admission will be cancelled and the admission fees will be forfeited.

**6. Combination of Subjects:**

**Arts:**

Students are required to take **one Major** (Any one among: *Bengali, English, History, Philosophy, Pol. Science, Sanskrit, Physical Education & Sports*) along with one **Minor** subject, one **Multidisciplinary** subject (Students are not allowed to choose or repeat courses already studied at the higher secondary level in the proposed major and minor stream under this category), one Ability Enhancement Course (AEC), One Skill Enhancement Course (SEC- Major Subject oriented) & One Value Added Course.

**Science:**

Students are required to take **one Major** (Any one among: Mathematics, Chemistry, Computer Science, Physics, Botany, Environmental Science, Zoology) along with one **Minor** subject, one **Multidisciplinary** subject (Students are not allowed to choose or repeat courses already studied at the higher secondary level in the proposed major and minor stream under this category), one Ability Enhancement Course (AEC), One Skill Enhancement Course (SEC- Major Subject oriented) & One Value Added Course.

**7. Merit Point calculation:**

- a) For **BENGALI, ENGLISH, SANSKRIT, MATHEMATICS, PHYSICS, CHEMISTRY**  
**Major:** sum of best 5 subjects in H.S or equivalent examination + marks obtained in respective Major subject in H.S or equivalent examination.
- b) For **HISTORY, PHILOSOPHY & POLITICAL SCIENCE, PHYSICAL EDUCATION, COMPUTER SCIENCE, BOTANY, ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE, ZOOLOGY**  
**Major:** sum of best 5 subjects in H.S or equivalent examination.

- 8.** At the time of counseling Major and combination subjects will be offered according to the choice of the applicants subject to the availability of seats. In case of applicants with same marks in aggregate, marks in the Madhyamik/Equivalent examination will be given priority.

## 9. RESERVATION GUIDELINES FOR THE APPLICANTS

### ► Reservation for SC, ST, OBC & PWD (Differently able) candidates:

Reservation of seats for SC/ST/OBC/Differently able candidates shall be as per Government rules as applicable at the time of admission.

Certificates in respect of SC/ST/OBC/Differently able candidates should be issued by appropriate authorities authorized by the respective Government in this regard within their respective jurisdictions (e.g. District Magistrate/District Collector/ Additional District Magistrate/Sub-Divisional Officer/Sub-Divisional Magistrate/ Deputy Collector/Executive Magistrate/Taluka Magistrate/Stipendiary Assistant Commissioner (not below the rank of First Class Magistrate)/Chief Presidency Magistrate/Additional Chief Presidency Magistrate/Presidency Magistrate/Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tehsildar/Deputy Commissioners/First Class Stipendiary Magistrate/Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Calcutta/Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Calcutta/Metropolitan Magistrate, Calcutta/Collector of Stamp Revenue, Calcutta/Deputy Collector of Land Revenue, Calcutta). Certificates issued by an appropriate authority, who have been authorized by the Government to issue such certificates in case of candidates claiming to be Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe candidates and ordinarily residing within such jurisdictions, may only be accepted.

► **Differently Abled Persons** (Certificates from at least Sub-Divisional level Govt. hospitals are necessary) Minimum degree of disability should be 40% in order to be eligible for any benefits.

### ► Orthopedically Handicapped/Locomotors disability/Cerebral Palsy

The Orthopedically Handicapped are those who have a physical defect or deformity which causes an interference with the normal functioning of the bones, muscles and joints. All cases of orthopedically handicapped persons would be covered under this category.

### ► Visually Handicapped (Blind and partially blind)

A person inflicted with any of the following disabilities shall be considered:

- i) Total absence of sight
- ii) With visual acuity not exceeding 6/60 or 20/200 (Sullen) in the better eye with correcting lenses
- iii) With limitation of the field of vision subtending an angle of 20 degrees or worse

The Visually Handicapped (VH) candidates should possess the latest certificates issued by an authorized hospital under the Govt. of India/State Governments.

### ► Hearing Impairment/Deafness

The deaf are those in whom the sense of hearing is non-functional for ordinary purposes of life. They do not hear or understand sounds at all events with amplified speech. The cases included in this category will be those having hearing loss for more than 60 decibels in the better ear (profound impairment) or total loss of hearing in both ears.

► Certificate of Category (SC/ST/OBC/PWD etc) must be produced during verification in college office. If a candidate fails to produce the above certificate, he/she will be dropped from the panel and the next candidate in the panel will be given the chance. Not more than one type of relaxation shall be granted to any candidate.

12. **A) Eligibility for admission into Major Subjects for all candidates:**

- a) **English:** Pass mark in aggregate + English as an elective subject with pass mark in H.S or equivalent examination
- b) **Bengali:** Pass mark in aggregate + Bengali as an elective subject with pass mark in H.S or equivalent examination
- c) **Sanskrit:** Pass mark in aggregate + Bengali as an elective subject with pass mark in H.S or equivalent examination
- d) **Political Science:** Pass mark in aggregate in H.S or equivalent examination
- e) **History:** Pass mark in aggregate in H.S or equivalent examination
- f) **Philosophy:** Pass mark in aggregate in H.S or equivalent examination
- g) **Physical Education & Sports:** Pass mark in aggregate in H.S or equivalent examination
- h) **Mathematics:** Pass mark in aggregate + Math as an elective subject with pass mark in H.S or equivalent examination
- i) **Chemistry:** Pass mark in aggregate + Chemistry as an elective subject with pass mark in H.S or equivalent examination
- j) **Physics:** Pass mark in aggregate + Physics as an elective subject with pass mark in H.S or equivalent examination
- k) **Computer Science:** Pass mark in aggregate in H.S or equivalent examination + Mathematics as an elective subject with pass mark in H.S or equivalent examination
- l) **Botany:** Pass mark in aggregate in H.S or equivalent examination
- m) **Zoology:** Pass mark in aggregate in H.S or equivalent examination
- n) **Environmental Science:** Pass mark in aggregate in H.S or equivalent examination
