Concept Note

The world poet Rabindranath Tagore, in his book, 'চরিত্রপূজা' (Charitrapuja) called Raja Rammohan Roy ভারতপথিক (Bharat Pathik) for his tremendous contributions to the development of human nation as a whole in general and for India particularly. Being the possessor of versatile knowledge, Raja Rammohan Roy at that time not only made a conscious effort for the eradication of the deep seated social customs such as child marriage, polygamy and so on, but also sincerely worked for the development of women, freedom of women, spreading of science based education, freedom of press, rights of the citizens and so on and practically paved the ways to handle these barriers through the interpretation of different sastras, making the public opinion as well as writing the petitions to the Government. In fact, he was not just a man of words, but a man of deeds. He, actually, revealed India to the Western World and the Western to India. At London, when he visited Manchester city, after seeing the work of railway track, he felt that the then England was about to get a new England from Britishers; at the same time, he hoped for a new India, initially, from the Britishers and thereby a new India for and from the pure Indians. The upcoming seminar is going to focus on Rammohan Roy as a social thinker and philosopher in its best possibilities from different aspects.

There will be a paper presentation session on the said theme. All types of academician/research scholar can send their abstract within the stipulated time following the proper guideline mentioned in this information booklet.
